Licensed Home Child Care is child care that is provided in the private residence of a caregiver. Individual home child care providers are not licensed by the Ministry of Education; they are contracted by home child care agencies that are licensed by the ministry.

An individual home child care provider that is overseen by a licensed agency can care for up to six children under the age of 13, which must include any of their own children under the age of four.
