

History of the Curling Club

- The Nosbonsing Curling Club began in the 1980's with curling on the Arena ice surface.
- In 1987 a group of community minded volunteers guaranteed loan funding to build a separate curling club.
- The Club continues to grow despite the impacts of the pandemic and has become an integral part of the community.





Success Stories

- We offer Mens, Womens, Mixed,
 Daytime and Youth Curling Leagues.
- Our Club has increased our membership over the last 5 years to approximately 125 members.
- We have made incremental investments in the club to improve the quality of the curling and social aspects of the club.





Success Stories

- Our Family Feud Bonspiel in conjunction with the East Ferris Winter Carnival is an annual success.
- During the 2018 Womens World Curling Championships, NCC Hosted the Cech Republic for practice sessions.
- TSN promoted our club and Community on National TV Coverage in 2018.





Growth of our Club


- The Nosbonsing Curling Club has evolved to be an integral part of the East Ferris recreation community.
- We promote an inclusive, social atmosphere supporting an active lifestyle through curling.
- Our membership has grown to approximately 125 members.
- Our Club is operated entirely through volunteer support.
- Club improvements are necessary to provide a sustainable, modern facility to maintain Curling as part of our vibrant community.






- Our goal is to improve the Curling Club through two major project initiatives:
 - ON-ICE Curling Environment
 - Club House Upgrades








- ON-ICE Curling Experience
 - The quality of curling ice and player comfort is dependent on controlled humidity and air temperature.
 - Proposed plan to install a
 Dehumidification system and improved Heating on the Ice Surface.
 - Estimated cost \$70K.





- ON-ICE Curling Experience
 - The existing carpeting on the playing area is at its end of life and degrading thus creating debris on the ice surface.
 - Proposed plan to install new commercial grade carpeting in the playing area.
 - Estimated cost \$10K.



- ON-ICE Curling Experience
 - The existing ceiling is a poly material that is soon to require replacement.
 - Proposed plan to install new low maintenance ceiling to improve the look in the club Estimated cost \$40K.





- ON-ICE Curling Experience
 - The ice maintenance facilities are split between two locations in the lounge and the ice area.
 - Proposed plan to consolidate the ice maintenance facilities into a single location on the ice area.
 - Estimated cost \$10K.









TOTAL	\$130k






- Club House Upgrades
- The objective of the upgrade:
 - Upgrade the Clubhouse and Lounge to meet the requirements of AODA
 - Modernize the Clubhouse to better utilize the space.
 - Modernize the Basement area to be better utilized for year round events.






- Club House Upgrades (2024)
- Accessibility throughout the club in accordance with AODA








- Club House Upgrades
- Reconfigure Washrooms in conjunction with Arena facilities.
- Include a universal washroom within the lounge layout that meets AODA.






- Club House Upgrades (2024)
- Upgrade HVAC in lounge/basement area to include air conditioning for year round use of facility..





Summary – Clubhouse

Item	Estimated \$k
Accessibility Lifts	\$60k*
Accessible Washroom	\$15K*
Reconfigure Floor Plan	\$150k*
Clubhouse Furniture	\$25k*
Upgrade HVAC	\$30k*
TOTAL	\$280k
* Cost estimates to be confirmed.	





Opportunities for Financing


- The Curling Club has raised money through various club initiatives to support capital improvements including stone refurbishment, new ice scraper, POS system.
- Approximately \$75k in available funds.






Opportunities for Financing

- Application to Government Grant programs.
 - NOHFC Community Enhancement Program.
 - Ontario Trillium Fund
 - Community Investment Capital Grant.



Next Steps:

- Work with the municipality to determine a strategic approach to achieve our goals.
- Update component estimates with current contractor estimates.
- Complete application for funding.
- Proceed with Upgrades if grant funding is available.
 - If grant funding is not approved, move forward to complete priority items within financial means.
