HOW DO WE COMPARE? 2022 ANNUAL SURVEY OF ONTARIO PUBLIC LIBRARIES

The Government of Ontario publishes reports on the survey results through the Ontario public library statistics program. The survey is updated every year to reflect changes in the public library sector.

Sample: This report compares libraries serving a population of 2,501 - 5,000 with a similar square footage.

Mean square footage = 2,399 sq/ft Standard deviation: 140.4 sq/ft
