THAT moving forward, any committee organizing a community event or function must inform the rest of the Council before the event takes place. This information should not only be shared on social media or through advertising but should also include details such as the cost or whether the committee plans to donate funds to the event;

AND THAT following the event, Council Members or the Mayor involved in the events should report back to the Council either verbally or in writing on the financials (under/over budget) and whether it was a success and a benefit to the community or not to continue with this event/function in a moving forward for next year.

AMENDED

THAT Council should be informed in advance, through committee meeting minutes, when Committees organize a community event or function, and the information should include details such as the cost in relation to the annual approved budget;

AND THAT following the event, the Council member or the Mayor who is Chair of the committee involved in the event should report back to Council, either verbally or in writing at a regular meeting, on the outcomes of the event, the financials as it relates to budget, the benefits to the community, and whether the event should take place in future years, if applicable.
