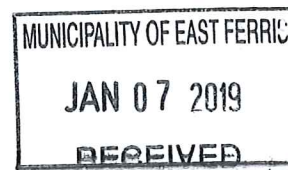

Dear Mayor Rochefort and Council Members,

As you may be aware the Nosbonsing Curling Club requires to be handicap accessible compliant by, I believe 2025. In preparation for this the Curling Club would like to explore the potential of an additional expansion of the club house area with the following changes:

- Expand the clubhouse area and take over the parking spaces (club house area only)
- Build a commercial kitchen and new bar in that area (main floor)
- Accommodate wheel chair access in new location entrance
- Remove existing bar, woman's washroom, fireplace and closet to increase permitted floor space from 48 to ~ 75.
- Convert men's washroom to unisex + wheel chair accessible

These changes would not only modernize the area but would also make it more accessible with the potential to be utilized by all on a year round basis.

To prepare for this the curling club would like the council's permission to send the attached letter to McEwen School of Architecture in Sudbury. The intent is to get some preliminary architectural sketches along with estimated costs for the changes. This would then allow our board to work with the community and other organizations in fundraising and grant efforts to have this completed and in place by 2025.

Please note that this is only an idea that I would like to explore further and not a commitment at this point. I would be pleased to meet with council member's to discuss this further at their convenience.

For the past few weeks I have been mulling over an idea and am soliciting your guidance and assistance if possible.

I am envisioning expanding our club house and am wondering if it is possible to provide this as a project to your architectural students. That is from conceptual drawings/sketches to even a full design.

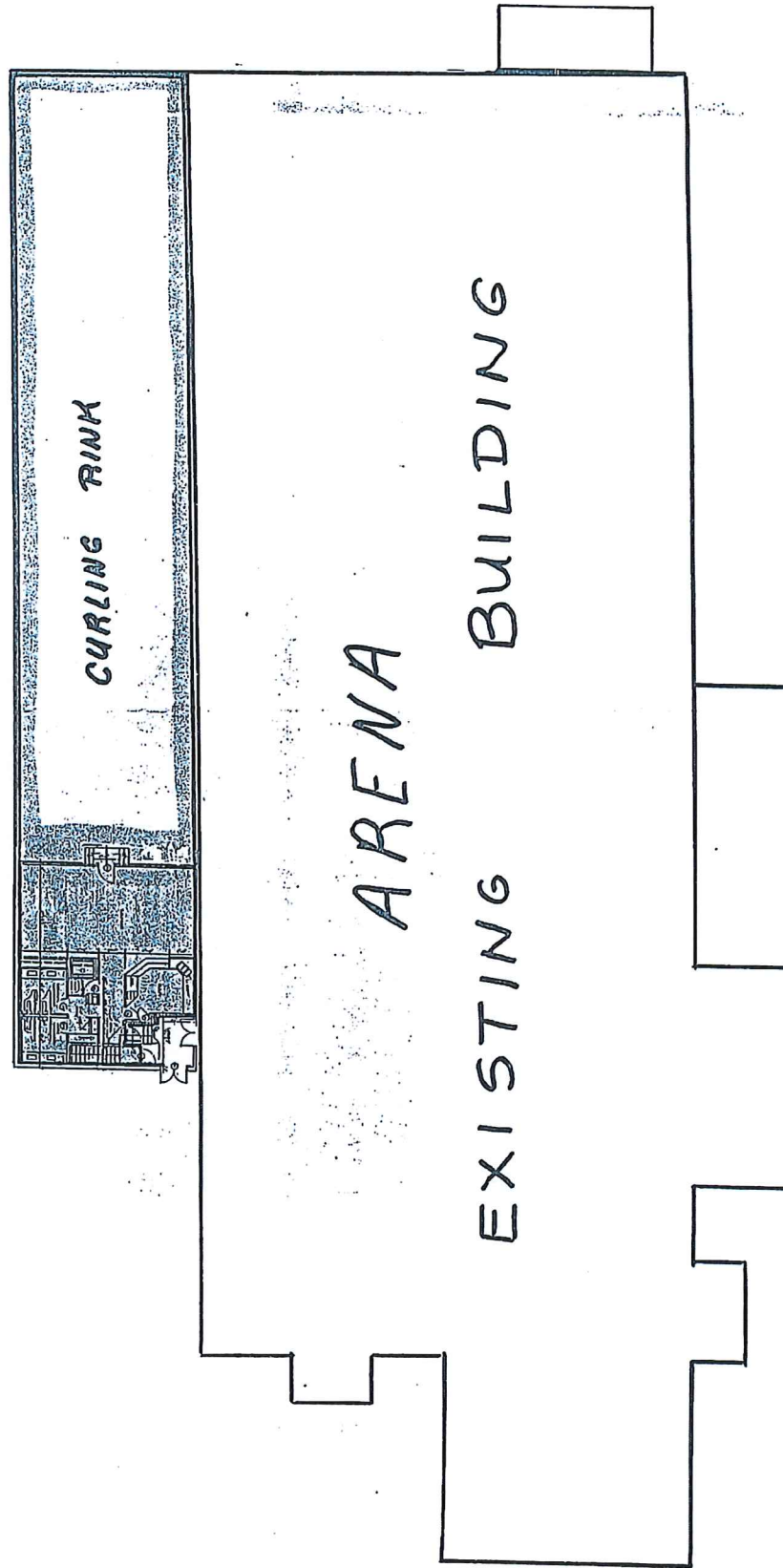
Trusting that this is a project that you would allow your students to take on and looking forward to hearing from you in the near future.
