As you may be aware the Nosbonsing Curling Club requires to be handicap accessible compliant by, I believe 2025. In preparation for this the Curling Club would like to <u>explore</u> the potential of an additional expansion of the club house area with the following changes:

- Expand the clubhouse area and take over the parking spaces (club house area only)
- Build a commercial kitchen and new bar in that area (main floor)
- Accommodate wheel chair access in new location entrance
- Remove existing bar, woman's washroom, fireplace and closet to increase permitted floor space from  $48 \text{ to} \sim 75$ .
- Convert men's washroom to unisex + wheel chair accessible

These changes would not only modernize the area but would also make it more accessible with the potential to be utilized by all on a year round basis.

To prepare for this the curling club would like the council's permission to send the attached letter to McEwen School of Architecture in Sudbury. The intent is to get some preliminary architectural sketches along with estimated costs for the changes. 
