# **NEW BUSINESS**

## Soccer Fees for 2020

Recreation Programs and Events Coordinator, Tammy Borgen-Flood advised the committee that the East Ferris and Callander Youth Soccer Program in 2019 had a surplus of revenue and recommends maintaining current registration rates at \$75.00 per child and \$70.00 for each additional child in the same household. The current fees By-Law 2019-22 stipulates that the fee for 2020 registration will increase to \$79.58 per child and \$74.26 for each additional child in the same household.

The East Ferris and Callander Youth Soccer Program is increasing in popularity and had 210 participants in 2019. Registrations fees and the confirmed sponsorship of \$1000.00 from Lucky 13 are expected to cover operating costs of the program for 2020.

The premise of the East Ferris and Callander Youth Soccer Program is to provide a low cost, fun program for local children, that promotes physical activity and removes barriers such as finances and location of programs, for local children to access them.

In addition, the even amounts of registration fees set at \$75.00 and \$70.00, reduce the administrative requirements for locations that accept registrations, as many do not accept debit/credit as a form of payment.

Due to the construction in Corbeil for new municipal offices, there is a risk that the soccer program in 2020 will require to use the Municipality of Callander's soccer fields for the entire program, as opposed to alternating the use of fields with Corbeil and Callander as traditionally done. This may discourage East Ferris residents from participating in the program. Maintaining program fees for 2020 will encourage residents to continue with the program.

The discussion resulted in the following Resolution:

## Resolution 2020-3

Lydia Weiskopf-Tran – Bill Ramore : That the Parks, Recreation and Culture Committee recommends to Council to amend the Fees and Charges By-Law 2019-22 to maintain Soccer Registration Fees for 2020 at \$75.00 per child, and \$70.00 for each additional child in the same family.
