

Informal meeting - October 25th, 2021

Under the umbrella of the Community Safety and Well Being Plan, a Sub Committee has been set up to review the possibilities of Bus Cameras (BusPatrol).

An informal meeting was set up for Monday, October 25th, 2021 with Councillor Champagne, Councillor Kelly, Mr. Claude Champagne, Mr. Matt Labonte, Mr. Pierre Ranger and Roberto Rego to get more information regarding bus cameras.

Mr. Rego and Mr. CSWB-Ranger advised that the roadblock that they are experiencing is with the City of North Bay, Since North Bay is the holder of the Provincial Offences for our area. Mr. Rego advised that the City of North Bay requires to be on board with bus cameras. Mr. Rego advised that the cost of the maintenance of the bus camera is \$150 per month per bus. The initial cost of the camera is \$5000.

Mr. Ranger will be providing a letter to the Municipality for the municipality to support and forward to municipalities in the District of Nipissing for support.
